PRAYER TIME

THIS IS YOUR DAILY PRAYER:

We know that in doing this we will find favor and high regard with You and others. May the world know You because of the way my family lives our life.

CONVERSATION STARTER: I was (re)reading in 1 John 4 and it tells us we love because God first loved us. What reminds you that God loves you?

READ THIS TOGETHER 1 John 3:1 *See what great love the Father has given us that we should be called God's children—and we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it didn't know him.*

SCRIPTURAL APPLICATION QUESTIONS

How has God showed His people that he loves them?

How is what Jesus did on the cross the ultimate show of love?

From this verse what can we learn about what God's love does for us? What can we also learn about how the world may see us because of this love

ACTIVITY TIME

WORDS OF AFFIRMATION

We each express and receive love differently. Words of affirmation is a way that many people feel loved. Words are not just vowels and consonants but can serve as active reminders of our love.
