4 Simple Ways You Can Make This Lesson Stick With your Kids

Bible Zoo Lesson 4

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: ALL THE ANIMALS

Use these four common times in a preschooler's day to reinforce this week's lesson:



DRIVING:

Explain to your little one some of the "rules of the road." Talk about why it is important to obey the signs and lights that tell you what to do. Relate it to the importance of obeying God when he asks us to do something.



PLAYING:

Play with your household pet and talk about all the things that make your pet unique. Go over the things that we have to do to keep that pet safe and content. What happens if we don't do what we're supposed to? How important is it to obey the rules of taking care of pets. (If you don't have a household pet, offer to watch a neighbor's pet for the afternoon. Or do some backyard exploring for small creatures.)



EATING:

As you talk together about your days, list some of the rules you had to obey that day. Talk about any moments where you felt God was asking you to do something and whether you found it easy or hard to obey. Remind little ones that because God loves us, we can obey him.



SNUGGLING:

Read together the story of Noah (Genesis 7:1-12) from a picture book or child-friendly version of the Bible. Talk about how hard it might have been to obey God, and remind little ones how important it is to obey God even when we don't understand why.
