THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE PRODIGAL SON'S DAD



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Jesus told a story about a man who had two sons. One son was very rude and disrespectful of his father. His father however, showed us how much God loves us and is willing to forgive us because when the disrespectful son returned, his father welcomed him with a hug rather than punishing him. Luke 15:11-24 The Prodigal Son



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

AT DINNER:

PARENT TIME:
