

Questions for Personal Bible Study

Four questions for understanding the passage:

1 - What do I learn about God?

Every book in the Bible points to God/Jesus. Look for:

- Character
- Conduct
- Concerns
- Trinity

2 - What do I learn about people?

- Our design as image bearers
- Sinful beliefs
- Attitudes
- Feeling
- Actions
- Tendencies

3 - What do I learn about relating to God?

- Reasons to Praise God
- What do I need to confess/repent?
- Promises from God

4 - What does this show me about relating to others?

- Family
- Friends
- Classmates
- Neighbors
- Fellow believers
- Non-Christians
- Reconciliation with others
- Loving, serving, caring for others

Four questions for applying the passage to your life:

1 - What does God want me to learn/think?

~Think our way or God's way

~What wrong ways of thinking does the passage expose for you?

2 - What does God want me to believe?

~What false beliefs does this passage reveal that you might have believed?

~What Gospel promises - promises from God does this passage show you?

3- What does God want me to desire?

~What sinful desires does this passage show that might show up in your life?

~God wants us to desire HIM more than anything else!

4 - What does God want me to do?

~What sinful actions in your life does this passage point out?

~What Godly actions should you pursue?
