THIS WEEK'S LESSON: DAVID



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

God chose David to be the new king himself. This made the current king, Saul, very angry. Saul tried to kill David. When David had the chance to get the jump on Saul, he chose compassion rather than anger. 1 Samuel 24:1-19, David Spares Saul's Life



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kids if there's a hard to love person they are trying to be kind to this week. Pray with them about that person, and encourage them to follow through on this week's challenge.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why was David hiding from Saul?
- Why did David show compassion to Saul?
- Why should we show love to people who are difficult to love?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Ephesians 4:32 (NIV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Loving your neighbor isn't so easy when your neighbor is so unlovable, but God wants us to love even the most difficult of people. Pray that God will help you to show love and compassion this week to someone you find difficult.
