Easter Eggs Lesson 1

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: BRIGHT AND BEAUTIFUL



DRIVING:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home: Play some worship music in the car. Sing together songs that emphasize Jesus' power as our king and Savior.



PLAYING:

Make this week's lesson real:

Play act the story of Jesus riding into town on Palm Sunday (John 12:12-15). Imagine what it would be like if Jesus rode right through your back yard. Use old clothes and fallen branches as props.



Serve up some fresh spinach. Talk about how they remind you of the palm branches that the people laid down as Jesus rode into town on the donkey. Wave the spinach leaves through the air before you eat them.



SNUGGLING:

Snuggle up together and read the memory verse together: "God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in him will not die but will have eternal life." John 3:16 (NIrV) Talk about the many ways we see God's love at work.
