THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE I AM...



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

To the people of the old testament-Abraham, Joseph, Moses- God was the great "I AM." When Jesus said, "before Abraham was born, I AM!" he was telling the people that he was God himself-he was with he Father from the beginning of time. John 8:42-59. Jesus Claims About Himself



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

What are some famous sayings in your family? Are any of your relatives known for saying things that are funny or profound? Ask your kids what statement of Jesus we discussed this week and what it means.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did Jesus call Himself "I AM?" What does it mean that Jesus is "I AM?"
- How do we know that Jesus is our Lord and God?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." Hebrews 13:8 (NIrV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

We will be discussing many of Jesus' claims about Himself during this upcoming series, but no statement is more important than "I AM." The Jews knew that only God Himself was "I AM," and this is the one time Jesus most clearly tells us who He is: our Lord and our God!
