# THIS WEEK'S LESSON: JOSEPH

## IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Sometimes we think we have to be a grown up for God to see us. But kids will learn that God is there protecting and providing for them right now. Genesis 37:12-36, Joseph Sold Into Slavery

#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

What "small" things are you always watching in your house? Bring those to your kids' attention, and see if they start to notice them. How is that like the way God watches over us?

- Why did Joseph's brothers sell him as a slave?
- How did God protect and watch over Joseph in Egypt?
- How do we know that God is watching over each one of us?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse: *"I can do all this by the power of Christ. He gives me strength." - Philippians 4:13 (NIrV)* 



#### **J** PARENT TIME:
