IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

And no one knew what it meant until God used Daniel to deliver an important message to the king. Daniel 5, The Writing on the Wall



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

AT DINNER:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

PARENT TIME:
