# THIS WEEK'S LESSON: ROTTEN!



## IN THE CAR:

On a drive, challenge your kids to be on the lookout for "broken" things: bumpy roads, busted sidewalk, a fallen stop sign. Discuss that things on earth are often not perfect. In heaven, everything will be new and perfect. We will see God and be with him forever.



### **HANGING OUT:**

Do some role playing and turn your play area into a doctor's office. Have kids (or yourself) come in with different ailments and be treated by the doctor. Afterward, talk about the fact that here on earth sometimes we get sick or have pain. People even die sometimes. But in heaven, everything is new. There is no sickness or pain. No death. In heaven, we will be with God forever.



#### AT DINNER:

For dinner one night, have a grand feast with everyone's favorite foods. Treat the night like a celebration. In the Bible, heaven is sometimes described as a grand feast. Imagine together what that dinner in heaven will be like.



### AT BEDTIME:

Snuggle up together and read the Memory Verse. Talk about the difference between earth and heaven. Here on earth, things get old. They rot and decay. But in heaven, everything is new. There will be no pain, decay, or death in heaven. Jesus makes all things new!
