THIS WEEK'S LESSON: SEEING SOUND



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

When Jesus said, "Follow me," the fishermen immediately left everything to become Jesus' disciples. The Seeing Sound experiment helped us visualize that when God calls us to action, we should move. Matthew 4:18-25, Jesus Calls the First Disciples



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Test the smoke alarms in your house, and any other alarms or devices that signal it's time to get moving. Ask your kids why it's important to obey God and to move into action when He calls us to act.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Whom did Jesus call to be his first disciples?
- Why did these men follow Him so quickly?
- How did the Seeing Sound experiment show you how to move when God speaks?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"You are the God who does miracles. You show your power among the nations."

PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:
